2014 Accomplishments

MEMBERSHIP – Recruited 9 new members and 4 former members rejoined; 2 members upgraded to Lifetime/Gold Plus (total of 15 members recruited in 2014)

NATIONAL PROGRAMS – Held NKH Chapter Youth Oratorical Competition (April 2014), 1st place winner Tyler N. Dixon, placed 3rd in the regional competition; Deena Sheppard, NKH Assistant Treasurer, participated and graduated from the Darlene Young Leadership Academy; and participated in National Webinars on workplace issues

CHAPTER PROGRAMS – Juneteenth program raised awareness of the historical significance of Juneteenth

COMMUNITY OUTREACH – February Heart Diseases Awareness Day (members wore red attire); speaker and participants for Operation PUSH's Annual Black History Month; Chapter Team (10 members) walked in the Federal Fitness Walk (May); collected more than 500 pairs of shoes to be recycled and donated to disadvantaged families

FINANCIAL – Complied with applicable IRS regulations; timely submittal of 990 form and ensured 2013 audit completed, all financial transactions reflected two signatories NATIONAL/REGIONAL FINANCIAL SUPPORT – Individual and chapter donations to National BIG's "Help Us Help Ourselves" Initiative; members completed quotes for National BIG Sponsor, GEICO; NKH Chapter placed ad in 2014 NTI Program Book; 8 chapter members participated in Project 144 to support Regional operations/scholarships
